#### ***Lenten Season***



Lent, the penitential season of the Church year, begins on **Ash Monday, February 19, 2007** and lasts until

Easter. The Lenten Season is a time of sacrifices throughout the Universal Church.

#### ***Distribution of Ashes***

Ashes will be distributed only on **Ash Monday, February 19, 2007** during the 9:00 A.M. and the 6:30 P.M. Liturgy.

#### ***Lenten Regulations***

All Maronites who are physically capable are to **abstain from meat** on Ash Monday (February 19) and all Fridays of Lent. Abstinence from meat means that no meat or meat product may be consumed on that day.

**Ash Monday and the Great Friday of the Crucifixion** are also days of **fasting**. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on these two days.

#### ***Devotion of Lenten Fridays***

Starting on **Friday, February 23, 2007 at 6:30 P.M.**, and every Friday of Lent thereafter, we will have **Stations of the Cross** followed by the **Benediction with the Cross**.
