Vatican Speaks Up on Road Rage

Negligence on the road results annually in 1.2 million deaths and 50 million injuries, a grim statistic that a Vatican official noted as he presented the "Guidelines for the Pastoral Care of the Road."

The document from the Pontifical Council for Migrants and Travelers was released on June 19, 2007. Its four sections cover issues ranging from road rage to ministering to prostitutes. And the document includes a list of "ten commandments" for drivers.

Ten Commandments For Drivers

The document highlights four virtues to apply on the road and offers the drivers' "ten commandments." The virtues are charity, prudence, justice and hope. The "Ten Commandments" for drivers, as listed in the document, are:

1. You shall not kill.
2. The road shall be for you a means of communion between people and not of mortal harm.
3. Courtesy, uprightness and prudence will help you deal with unforeseen events.
4. Be charitable and help your neighbor in need, especially victims of accidents.
5. Cars shall not be for you an expression of power and domination and an occasion of sin.
6. Charitably convince the young and not so young not to drive when they are not in a fitting condition to do so.
7. Support the families of accident victims.
8. Bring guilty motorists and their victims together, at the appropriate time, so that they can undergo the liberating experience of forgiveness.
9. On the road, protect the more vulnerable party.
10. Feel responsible toward others.
