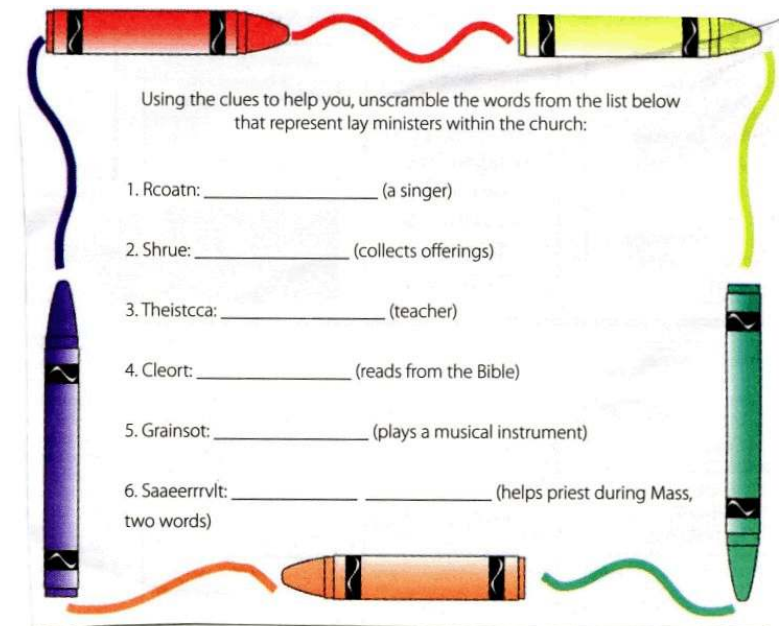
What does 40 Day Memorial Service mean?

The custom of celebrating the Eucharist 40 days after the death of the believer probably has its roots in the *refrigerium* service of ancient Christianity. The period of mourning came to last for forty days, after which the mourners shared the Eucharist; a common meal of physical and spiritual refreshment, and memories of the deceased. The number 40 is likely related to the biblical idea of 40 being a special number (Noah in the ark, Jesus' fasting in the desert).

What is Purgatory?

Purgatory, often imagined as a place, is actually a condition. Someone who dies in God's grace (and therefore at peace with God and men) but who still needs purification before he can see God face to face is in purgatory.

When Peter had betrayed Jesus, the Lord turned around and looked at Peter: "And Peter went out and wept bitterly" a feeling like being in purgatory. Just such a purgatory probably awaits most of us at the moment of our death: the Lord looks at us full of

love and we experience burning shame and painful remorse over our wicked or "merely" unloving behavior. Only after this purifying pain will we be capable of meeting his loving gaze in untroubled heavenly joy. (YOUCAT 159)
